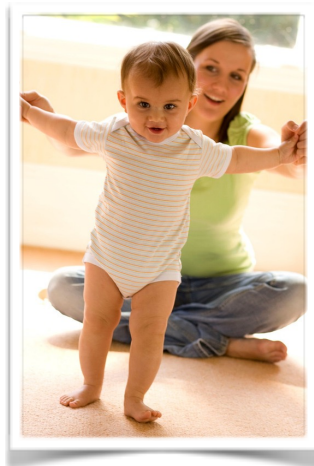
How can you
support us?

Mental health, and in particular children's mental health, is finally beginning to get the public attention it deserves. Over the past year, over 200 families have accessed OXPIP's specialist therapeutic support. Our services have never been more crucial and relevant, but we receive no statutory funding.

What is OXPIP?

Research tells us that early experiences and damaged relationships can have lifelong consequences. For over 20 years, OXPIP has helped parents and their babies to build strong and loving relationships. We offer intensive therapeutic help to parents and babies from conception to two years in Oxfordshire and surrounding areas.

Parents come to us for a variety of reasons including post-natal depression, a baby that struggles to sleep or feed, anxieties about parenthood, a difficult/traumatic birth experience or issues from a parent's own past.



Why is our work valuable?



We have pioneered a unique and specialist form of therapy. Our highly experienced clinicians work with parents and infant together, to build on positive interactions, boost parental confidence and help parents understand the needs of their baby.

OXPIP is a preventative service and for every £1 spent in this early, preventative window, £9 is saved on future interventions (Wave Trust, Age of Opportunity report, 2013).
